## Introduction

Our wine philosophy is straightforward. In terms of style, we look for wines of balance, wines that are true to type (representative of their origins), and wines that will complement our style of food. In terms of pricing, our aim is to offer excellent value at each price point. This is particularly noticeable as you move through the price ranges with only small “cash” margins applied to our more premium wines.

To help select our wines, we work closely with our wine consultant / supplier, Miles Corish MW from Milestone Wines. Miles is one of only 352 global Masters of Wine and over the last 25 years, has developed relationships with a strong portfolio of smaller, quality focused wine producers. Wherever possible, we prefer to offer these wines to our customers as in our opinion, not only do smaller producers inevitably offer a superior combination of quality and value of money, many of those that appear in our list are benchmark producers for their region.

In an attempt to make it easier for customers, we have listed our whites and reds into four “categories” or “styles”. Hopefully this will lead to a degree of experimentation and add value to your dining experience. Wine is always subjective and there are seldom absolutes when categorising style – one person’s medium body is another person’s light body – so with this in mind, we are well aware that some individual wines could straddle more than one style category. Allowing for these anomalies however, we do hope that you enjoy our selection and welcome your comments and feedback.

Vintages and prices are subject to change without notice as we prefer to work with smaller wine producers, there are the odd occasions when a wine is unavailable. We aim to keep this to a minimum, and our staff will assist with an alternative wine, in the event that a wine is not available.

### White Wines

**39 - Villarrica Sauvignon Blanc 2016, Maule Valley, Chile** 4.00 5.50 19.50

This wine is a fresh, displaying perfumed citrus and tropical fruit characters. There are hints of grapefruit and elderflower on the palate with a lively and vibrant finish. A lovely example of Sauvignon.

**31 - La Casada Pinot Grigio 2016, Veneto, Italy** 4.00 5.50 19.50

So often Pinot Grigio is inexpensive and dull. La Casada on the other hand offers gentle pear flavours, hints of acacia, in a refreshing and well-balanced package.

**36 - Villiera Chenin Blanc 2015, Stellenbosch, South Africa** 5.00 7.00 24.00

Owned by the Grier family, Villiera is a 180 hectare estate started in 1983. An absolutely delicious Chenin exhibiting intense stone fruit with honey and hints of wood spice on the nose. The rich, rounded palate reveals pineapple, guava and citrus fruits, is beautifully balanced with a very long finish.

**40 - The Courtesan Riesling 2015, Australia** 5.50 7.50 26.50

The fruit for this fantastic wine heralds from the famed Watervale region within South Australia (a sub-region of the Clare Valley). A mouth watering combination of limes, elderflower with hints of grapefruit. The palate is balanced and refreshing – an excellent example of modern Riesling.

**38 - Lagar da Xestosa Godello 2015, Monterrei, Spain** 6.00 8.00 28.00

Growing in popularity, and produced in the right hands, Godello can make truly delicious white wine. Family run, Adegas Pazo do Mar combine modern techniques with traditional know-how to fashion this stunning example. Intense citrus flavours combine with lemongrass and honeydew melon to create a soft, flavoursome palate.

**45 - Domaine Drouin Macon Bussieres 2015, Burgundy** 7.00 9.00 31.00

Classic white Burgundy, Domaine Drouin has developed a well-earned reputation for over delivering when it comes to value for money. Nectarine, toasted almonds and citrus fruits abound, and careful use of oak makes for a sumptuous palate. Amazing value.

### Rosé Wines

**61 - Sugarbird White Zinfandel 2016, California** 4.00 5.50 17.50

Jam packed with ripe strawberries, juicy kiwi fruit and watermelons. A lingering finish is reminiscent of nectarines. Sugarbird is mouth-filling aperitif for those that prefer a sweeter style of Rosé.

**63 - Uvam, Pinot Grigio Blush delle Venezie, IGT Veneto, Italy, 2015** 5.00 7.00 23.50

This Pinot Grigio Blush is created from a selection of the best grapes situated on the foothills of Veneto. This particular location gives the wine a delicacy and sophistication not seen in inexpensive Pinot Grigio Blush. Light copper colour with an elegant nose of red fruits, and a floral scented background. Fresh, mineral and well balanced, with persistent fruity aftertaste.

## Red Wines

- 71 - Villarrica Merlot 2015, Curico Valley, Chile** 4.00 5.50 19.50  
Red purple colour with sweet aromas of ripe black cherries and plums. Soft and silky on the palate, where blackberry flavours and hints of pepper support a lovely elegant finish.
- 80 - The Liberator 'The Francophile' Syrah 2015, Stellenbosch, SA** 5.00 7.00 24.00  
As the name suggests, this Syrah (or Shiraz as Aussies call it) is more of a French expression of the grape variety. The liberator exudes lots of juicy black fruits, hints of pepper and spice and could be thought of as a baby Crozes-Hermitage.
- 73 - Santa Macarena Pinot Noir, Espinos y Cardos, Chile, 2015** 5.00 7.00 24.50  
A single vineyard Pinot Noir from one of the coolest climate, coastal vineyards in Chile, San Antonio. Bright, and fresh with red fruits, floral notes well supported by subtle oak. The emphasis is on drinkability and enjoyment. A seriously cool Pinot.
- 76 - Abraham & Heretics Pinotage 2015, South Africa** 5.50 7.50 26.00  
A medium bodied Pinotage laden with red fruits, earth and hints of spice. Unusually for Pinotage, it manages to avoid the rubbery, overly herbal notes sometimes found with this grape variety. Finishing with a balance between crunchy fruit and acid.
- 78 - El Cipres Malbec 2016, Mendoza, Argentina** 5.50 7.50 27.00  
For over 150 years, Luis Segundo Correas (El Cipres) has developed a reputation for handcrafting top quality Malbec. A wonderful example exhibiting floral, black cherry and plum on the nose which leads onto a very silky, blackberry and chocolate palate. A fine example of cool-climate Malbec, superb.
- 85 - Ironstone Old Vine Zinfandel 2015, California** 6.50 8.50 30.00  
This fantastic Zinfandel has exceptional varietal character with lovely aromas of blackberry and liquorice. The palate is full-bodied with multiple layers of raspberry, raisins and ripe plums. Barrel ageing has created a smooth, silky finish and unprecedented depth.

Rich, full, complex and toasty. Hints of fresh citrus add freshness to the palate. Fine, persistent bubbles and a long finish, perfectly complement the wine's structure.

### **11 - Charles Pelletier 'Cuvee Rosé' Grande Reserve** 25.00

Pelletier is made by the renowned Crémant de Bourgogne house of Veuve-Ambal that dates back to 1898. A delightfully elegant Rosé exhibiting succulent red fruits, refreshing acidity and a lingering palate. A lovely aperitif.

### **12 - Mionetto Avantgarde Prosecco D.O.C Treviso Brut** 26.00

Founded in 1887 by Francesco Mionetto in the small village of Valdobbiadene, Mionetto has established a global reputation for quality, tradition and innovation. Light straw in colour with aromas of golden apples, pear and honey. The palate is beautifully balanced with a fresh and lively mouth feel and a refreshing finish.

### **13 - Truslers Hill Pinot Noir Rose, Albourne, UK** 49.00

An example of just how great English sparkling wine can be. Truslers is created from only the finest hand-picked whole bunches, which are gently pressed and after a short period of skin contact are fermented in temperature controlled tanks. Using traditional methods for the secondary fermentation, it is aged on lees for 9 months prior to release. A bright, vibrant richly coloured Rosé with delicious fresh English strawberries and cream on the nose and palate. A perfect summers day drink....

## Champagne

### **21 - Pierre Mignon Grande Reserve Premier Cru Champagne, France** 55.00

Mignon produces stylish Champagnes with a fresh, vibrant character, within their own cellars where attention to detail and quality is paramount. Hand selected grapes coming from only Premier Cru Vineyards has created a Champagne with delicate citrus fruits, overlaid with touches of brioche and yeastiness. The palate is fresh, clean and lively with a creamy mousse and long finish.

### **22 - Champagne Brimoncourt Brut Regence, France** 65.00

The founding idea of Champagne Brimoncourt is "to get back to the original DNA of Champagne, to the time when it was a light and joyful wine, a wine that was drunk with friends, a wine for meeting with people but not at all formal". Simply stunning Champagne, Régence has great aromatic finesse and seduces with its freshness, round texture and delicately fruity finish.

### **23 - Vilmart Grande Reserve NV Brut, France** 75.00

For those in the know, grower Champagne usually offers superior value compared to 'high profile brands'. Widely regarded as one the best grower Champagne currently made, Vilmart combines white peach, delicate creamy flavours, and a super long refined finish. Top drawer!

## Zingy, Refreshing Whites

Bottle

Within this section, you will find wines that exhibit a zingy freshness. Most often these wines are dry, light-bodied, mostly un-oaked, and usually possess crisp levels of acidity. Given their overall structure, these wines are suitable to consume on their own as an aperitif, and they make ideal partners with white fish, shellfish, or dishes that contain acidic elements, such as vinaigrettes.

### **30 - Campo Azafran Airen Sauvignon 2015/16, Spain** 18.50

Azafran is Spanish for Saffron, wildly used to add spice to local cuisine. With quality in mind, Campo Azafran has created an ideal collection of wines, designed to complement food. Citrus fruits with hints of mineral, beautifully balanced with an elegant, crisp, finish.

### **31 - La Casada Pinot Grigio 2016, Veneto, Italy** 19.50

So often Pinot Grigio is inexpensive and dull. La Casada on the other hand offers gentle pear flavours, hints of acacia, in a refreshing and well-balanced package.

### **32 - Corzetti Gavi D.O.C.G 2015, Piedmont, Italy** 28.50

For those seeking a wine that epitomises a zingy refreshing white, then look no further. Corzetti encapsulates an abundance of white flowers, hints of grapefruit and fresh pistachio nuts. The palate is elegant and balanced with zippy fresh acidity.

### **33 - Bodegas Calazul Albarino 2015, Rias Baixas, Spain** 31.95

Founded in 2009, the Calazul winery is specifically located in the Salnés Valley where the Albariño grape traditionally develops its maximum quality and strength. An intense nose of stone fruits and apple, lead onto a beautifully balanced palate with crisp acidity and a lingering mineral finish.

### **34 - Domaine Tremblay Chablis 2015, France** 38.00

There are thousands of Chablis produced each year, all with marked differences. To find a good one, you need to look beyond the word 'Chablis' and find out who makes it. Tremblay are boutiques producers in Chablis and using old vines they handcraft top examples from this classy region. Stone fruits, pebbles and hints of flint combine with an elegant applely finish.

## Rounded Whites

Bottle

Typically, this style of white wine isn't usually noticeably aromatic; tending to be slightly more full-bodied, and in some cases, contain a little less prominent acidity than other categories. Given their structure, they lend themselves to partnering slightly heavier dishes than "zingy, refreshing whites". One of the more versatile white styles in our list, "rounded whites" are capable of matching a wide range of foods. Enjoy with fish, scallops, salads and light risottos.

### **35 - Simonsvlei Chardonnay 2014, South Africa** 19.50

Chardonnay is enjoying a well-deserved comeback with wines such as this offering outstanding value. Attractive melon and citrus notes on the nose, with apricots and mandarin flavours on the palate. This is a lovely rich chardonnay yet beautifully balanced by crisp, refreshing acidity.

### **36 - Villiera Chenin Blanc 2015, Stellenbosch, South Africa** 24.00

Owned by the Grier family, Villiera is a 180 hectare estate started in 1983. An absolutely delicious Chenin exhibiting intense stone fruit with honey and hints of wood spice on the nose. The rich, rounded palate reveals pineapple, guava and citrus fruits, is beautifully balanced with a very long finish.

### **37 - Montsable Chardonnay 2015, IGP Pays d'Oc, Languedoc, France** 25.00

Although warmer than the cool climate of Burgundy great care has been taken to ensure that Montsable is every bit as elegant. This classy Chardonnay possesses seductive scents of blossom and cinnamon spice on the nose. This leads to pears, peach, cream and vanilla (from a short spell of oak ageing) on the palate. Beautifully balanced with ripeness, acidity, length and real structure.

### **38 - Lagar da Xestosa Godello 2015, Monterrei, Spain** 28.00

Growing in popularity, and produced in the right hands, Godello can make truly delicious white wine. Family run, Adegas Pazo do Mar combine modern techniques with traditional knowhow to fashion this stunning example. Intense citrus flavours combine with lemongrass and honeydew melon to create a soft, flavoursome palate.

## Aromatic Whites

"Aromatic" white styles tend to be naturally pungent, often created from grape varieties whose inherent perfume shines through in the glass. In contrast, more "neutral" styles of white are often made with grape varieties that possess 'less' natural 'perfume' and sometimes owe more of their character to external influences such as winemaking techniques (for example whites that are matured in new oak barrels). Aromatic whites make ideal partners to dishes that have reasonably strong flavours, creating a great foil for spicy dishes or those that have a degree of sweetness.

### **39 - Villarrica Sauvignon Blanc 2016, Maule Valley, Chile** 19.50

Villarrica Sauvignon Blanc is fresh, displaying perfumed citrus and tropical fruit characters. There are hints of grapefruit and elderflower on the palate with a lively and vibrant finish. A lovely example of Sauvignon.

### **40 - The Courtesan Riesling 2015, Australia** 26.50

The fruit for this fantastic wine heralds from the famed Watervale region with South Australia (a sub-region of the Clare Valley). A mouthwatering combination of limes, elderflower with hints of grapefruit. The palate is balanced and refreshing – an excellent example of modern Riesling.

### **41 - Fairhall Downs Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2015, New Zealand** 34.50

One of the first growers in Marlborough (1982), this family estate creates small quantities of top-notch NZ Sauvignon. Intense passion fruit, guava and tomato stalk on the nose. Melon and citrus fruits provide complexity on the delicately poised palate, and a superb finish completes this joyful experience.

### **42 - Luis Clerc Viognier 2015, Vin de France, France** 38.00

Louis Clerc is famous for his top Condrieu, but his "simple" Viognier is absolutely knock-out! Just outside the AOC area for Condrieu, it is loaded with peaches and apricots, but combines minerality and elegance at the same time. A wine for contemplation as the harder you look the more you find...

## Punchy, Full-bodied Whites

Bottle

Styles of this category are definitely on the weighty side and are ideal for those who prefer full-bodied, creamy, mouth-filling wines. Invariably “punchy, full-bodied” whites will have been made with a degree of barrel fermentation / barrel ageing and from grape varieties known for their ability to produce rich, mouth coating wines. Wines in this section are able to partner strong flavours such as char-grilled chicken, salmon / smoked salmon and even white meats such as pork.

### **43 - Navajas Blanco Crianza 2013, Rioja, Spain** 27.00

A lovely creamy style of white Rioja with hints of almonds, passionfruit and toast. A great balance between oak and freshness - a great introduction into our full-bodied section.

### **44 - Tenute Rubino, 'Marmorelle', Salento Bianco, Puglia, Italy, 2015** 29.00

The single vineyard of Marmorelle, was planted in 1998 to Chardonnay and Malvasia Bianca. These combine to create a delicious wine which is straw yellow in colour with intense floral notes, red apple, peach, apricot and almond. Soft and full, with a lovely textured and persistent finish.

### **45 - Domaine Drouin Macon Bussieres 2015, Burgundy, France** 31.00

Classic white Burgundy, Domaine Drouin has developed a well-earned reputation for over delivering when it comes to value for money. Nectarine, toasted almonds and citrus fruits abound, and careful use of oak makes for a sumptuous palate. Amazing value.

### **46 - Domaine Jaegar - Defaix Rully 1er Cru 'Mont-Palais' Blanc 2014, France** 55.00

In October 2002, Hélène Jaeger-Defaix, took over her first vineyard in Rully 1er cru Mont-Palais white (South Burgundy) and is now renowned for making the best whites in Rully. Organically farmed using 40-50 year old vines, the abundance of ripe peach, marzipan and toast creates a lovely richness and texture. Long, creamy and delicious.

### **47 - Domaine Pillot, Chassagne-Montrachet Blanc, Burgundy, France, 2015** 85.00

Laurent Pillot, took over the running of Domaine Pillot in his mid-twenties, and has transformed his family estate into one of the superstars of Chassagne-Montrachet. Concentrated and balanced with limes, peach and background hints of hazelnuts. Manages to combine power and elegance leading onto an amazing finish. Top draw.

**61 - Sugarbird White Zinfandel 2016, California**

Jam packed with ripe strawberries, juicy kiwi fruit and watermelons. A lingering finish is reminiscent of nectarines. Sugarbird is mouth-filling aperitif for those that prefer a sweeter style of Rosé.

**62 - Eagles Cliff Rose 2015, South Africa**

Loaded with strawberries and black cherries this classy rosé is a fuller style and one of South Africa's best examples of sunshine in a glass. Enjoy.

**63 - Uvam, Pinot Grigio Blush delle Venezie, IGT Veneto, Italy, 2015**

23.50

This Pinot Grigio Blush is created from a selection of the best grapes situated on the foothills of Veneto. This particular location gives the wine a delicacy and sophistication not seen in inexpensive Pinot Grigio Blush. Light copper colour with an elegant nose of red fruits, and a floral scented background. Fresh, mineral and well balanced, with persistent fruity aftertaste.

**64 - Ravoire et Fils, Cuvée Des Lices, Côtes de Provence, France, 2015**

28.00

A fresh and balanced rosé that captures the spirit of the Cote d'Azur with its strawberry and white peach flavours. Crisp, bright and lively, it is real pleasure and the red berry fruits burst out of the glass, lifted by delicious acidity.

## Light, Elegant and Easy Reds

Bottle

Red wines within this section, display fresh fruit aromas and a softness that makes them great on their own or with lighter styles of food. Whilst lovers of “big reds” sometimes overlook these wines, they deserve a place on every wine list, especially when one considers their suitability with certain foods. The juicy fruit flavours and refreshing acidity of these reds mean they are a great accompaniment for poultry, pasta, pork and creamy cheeses.

### **70 - Campo Azafran Tempranillo Syrah 2015/16, Vdt Castilla, Spain** 18.50

On the nose, Campo Azafran is fresh and elegant with characteristic aromas of cherry and red fruits typical of Tempranillo. Light, harmonious and round on the palate with soft tannins.

### **71 - Villarrica Merlot 2015, Curico Valley, Chile** 19.50

Red purple colour with sweet aromas of ripe black cherries and plums. Soft and silky on the palate, where blackberry flavours and hints of pepper support a lovely elegant finish.

### **72 - Vina Rufina Tempranillo 2014, Cigales, Spain** 23.00

Blackberry and red forest fruits aromas lead onto a creamy, vanillin palate. The palate is fresh and fruity, backed by earthy tannins and a good persistence.

### **73 - Santa Macarena Pinot Noir, Espinos y Cardos, Chile, 2015** 24.50

A single vineyard Pinot Noir from one of the coolest climate, coastal vineyards in Chile, San Antonio. Bright, and fresh with red fruits, floral notes well supported by subtle oak. The emphasis is on drinkability and enjoyment. A seriously cool Pinot.

### **74 - Cave Saint-Verny 'Les Volcans' Gamay-Pinot Noir 2015, France** 28.50

This is a fascinating blend historically produced in Cotes d'Auvergne (and of course Burgundy). Lovely sweet mixed berry fruit is cushioned by soft tannins, and refreshing levels of acidity. One not to overlook.

Spicy reds cover a wide array of grape varieties, aromas and flavours. These wines are characterised by medium tannins and generally possess a softer, more rounded mouth feel. Spicy rounded wines are suitable for a wide range of foods, ranging from poultry, to lighter red meat dishes (such as lamb), through to charcuterie.

**75 - Terra Firma Nero d'Avola 2015, Sicily, Italy**

24.00

Nero d'Avola from its original home near Pachino has been enlivened with 40% of fruit sourced high in the mountains near Palermo; Terra Firma is ripe and full-bodied but it still has a lively lick of acidity. It's enticing, plummy and a definite cut above the sometimes bland examples, that can be produced by Nero d'Avola. Very appealing.

**76 - Amraham & Heretics Pinotage 2015, South Africa**

26.00

A medium bodied Pinotage laden with redfruits, earth and hints of spice. Unusually for Pinotage, it manages to avoid the rubbery / overly herbal notes sometimes found with this grape variety. Finishing with a balance between crunchy fruit and acid.

**77 - Cotes du Rhone 'Blasson' 2015, Rhone, France**

25.00

Sourced from some of the better vineyards in the Southern Rhone, Blasson have created a soft, and rounded Cotes du Rhone. A blend of 50% Grenache, 30% Syrah and 20% Mouvedre combine to produce a wine laden with spicy blackberries, hints of liquorice and background 'garrigue'.

**78 - El Cipres Malbec 2016, Mendoza, Argentina**

27.00

For over 150 years, Luis Segundo Correas (El Cipres) has developed a reputation for handcrafting top quality Malbec. A wonderful example exhibiting floral, black cherry and plum on the nose which leads onto a very silky, blackberry and chocolate palate. A fine example of cool-climate Malbec, superb.

**79 - Luis Canas Crianza 2014, Rioja, Spain**

38.00

Outstanding Rioja from one of the regions' best estates. Aromas of strawberry, hints of vanilla, cedar and balsamic nuances, lead onto dense dark fruit flavours. Crisp acidity gives a lovely freshness to the wine. A great match to lamb or beef. A stunning wine and a huge leap above 'normal' Rioja!

## Full-Bodied Reds

Bottle

Full-bodied reds are mouth-coating; a result of wine made from 'weightier' grape varieties and / or the wine spending some time in oak barrels. They usually contain moderate to high levels of tannins and cover a spectrum of colours (not just deep red). These wines make suitable partners to stronger foods. Try with red meats (particularly beef), venison and hard cheese.

### **80 - The Liberator 'The Francophile' Syrah 2015, Stellenbosch, South Africa** 24.00

As the name suggests, this Syrah (or Shiraz as Aussies call it) is more of a French expression of the grape variety. The Liberator exudes lots of juicy black fruits, hints of pepper and spice and could be thought of as a baby Crozes-Hermitage.

### **81 - Buil & Gine Gine 2014, Priorat, Spain** 39.00

Remarkable value (Priorat has a reputation as unobtainable for most) this classy and fabulous example exhibits intense notes of flowers, fruits and minerals. The palate is fresh, very fruity, round, balanced and very long.

### **82 - Chateau Caronne St Gemme 2011, Bordeaux, France** 43.00

Dusky blackberry and hedgerow fruit are in abundance with a subtly medicinal note of cedar and a lick of toasty new oak. Structural tannins and fresh acidity provide a framework for this impressively endowed wine.

### **83 - Redman Shiraz 2012, Coonawarra, Australia** 45.00

From an epic vintage comes this full-bodied, spicy, history-laden Australian Shiraz that shows blackberries, red fruits and toasty cedar. The palate is sweetly-fruited and spiced, with hints of herbs and earthiness, a firm yet ripe tannins, and a lingering spicy finish. Try it with steak and pepper sauce.

### **84 - Domaine Bachey Legros Santenay "La Comme" 2013, Burgundy, France** 59.00

Legros have been handcrafting Burgundy for six generations and this knowledge shows through in the quality of their wines. This is a velvety Burgundy offering loads of dark cherry, plums, and mineral flavours. There is a lot of flavour for Pinot lovers here – far removed from the basic "Bourgogne" style.

As the heading suggests, this section comprises our most powerful reds. These wines are rich, often laden with luscious fruit, and in many cases, possess strong tannins. Maturation in oak barrels has enhanced the wine flavour and structure of a number of these wines, providing them with extra depth and a robust character. For those seeking power, character and balance, reds from this section should fit the bill! Best matched with powerful meats, game, and blue cheeses.

**85 - Ironstone Old Vine Zinfandel 2015, California**

This fantastic Zinfandel has exceptional varietal character with lovely aromas of blackberry and liquorice. The palate is full-bodied with multiple layers of raspberry, raisins and ripe plums. Barrel aging created its smooth, silky finish and unprecedented depth.

**86 - Dominio de Cair Cuvee de Cair 2014, Ribera del Duero, Spain**

Ribera del Duero has long been one of the most revered regions of Spain thanks to the presence of Vega Sicilia since the 19th century. Bright, complex and enticing aromas of blackberry, graphite and black cherry. Creamy notes combine with some spice on the palate which is nicely rounded thanks to 9 months ageing in older French oak. Smooth and stylish.

**87 - Maurodos Prima 2012, Toro, Spain**

A stunning wine from the up and coming Toro region. Packed with black cherry, plums and crunchy blueberry flavours, the palate has exceptional concentration which along with the fruit, is bolstered by a smoky, earthy element. This has very impressive length and lots of spice on the finish.

**88 - Mas de Boislauzon Chateauneuf du Pape 2010, Rhone Valley, France**

65.00 Boislauzons Chateauneuf du Pape is prestigious effort - regularly spoken about as one of the region's best. Ripe, voluptuous and possesses loads of texture and richness, yet is also well balanced. Offering up knockout notes of blackberry, underbrush, liquorice and black cherry fruit, this full-bodied wine needs time in the glass to show its true potential. Sublime.

**89 - Biscardo Amarone di Valpolicella, DOCG, Veneto, Italy, 2012**

69.00

The vineyards for this wonderful Amarone lie on the hill of the little towns around Verona at around 150 to 400 metres altitude. This elevation adds a perfume to this wine which is a great example of the world famous Amarone style. Deep dark figs and black cherries abound on the rich (yet silky) palate. Long and concentrated.
